**Parents – you’re encouraged to visit www.coe22.com/students and under the video on the webpage there is a red button titled “Parent Resources.” When clicking this button, you’ll find resources that might be helpful to you as you disciple your student at home.

1. What is one thing that stuck out to you from Pastor Joby’s talk.
2. **READ Matthew 7:24-27.** What are the two different foundations that Jesus says we build our life on and what do they represent? [sand = things of the world...stuff/status & Rock = Gospel truth]
3. What is the gospel? How would you define the gospel to your friends? What does it look like for someone to build their life on the gospel?
4. Where in your life might you be tempted to build your life on something other than the gospel? And what would that look like specifically in your life? [great opportunity for you as a parent to connect by answering this question honestly with your student]
5. When the rain falls and floods come (AKA hard times/trials) why is it important for us to have our lives built on the gospel?
6. If you are being honest what is the foundation of your life built on? [Pray with and for your student after this]
7. Check out as a family the song, “Build My Life” by Housefires on YouTube or Spotify. Talk about parts of the song that stick out most and pray over those areas.

Parents – as you end your conversation together, pray for your student. Pray that the gospel of Jesus Christ would continue to take root in their heart, soul, mind and strength. The gospel declares it is not about what we do but it IS about what has been done FOR us through the person and finished work of Jesus Christ on the cross. This is Good News. Pray these things over your student...this will be a powerful way to end your time.
