## LOUD MOUTH: WEEK 1

**THE POINT:** What do you do with doubts and unanswered questions? You pick them up and follow after Jesus because He is the only one that offers eternal life.

SERMON TEXTS: John 6:22-71

## Discussion Questions

(The goal is to grow in our relationship with Christ and each other. It is ok if you don't cover every question.)

## DISCOVER

### [PLAY VIDEO]

Read John 6:22-65 out loud as a group. Either assign verses to each person or rotate around the room.

1. **When have you experienced God through an answered or unanswered prayer?** *(Answers may vary. Either answer is an opportunity to rejoice in the Lord, as Paul tells us in Romans 12:12 – rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, and constant in prayer.)*
2. **What is Jesus telling his disciples in this passage that is so controversial? Why is His message still controversial today?** *(There is only ONE way and it is by grace alone, through faith alone in Christ alone. In verse 29, Jesus states that we cannot work or earn our way into God's favor. It's radically different than every other religion. Every man-made religion falls back onto the idea that "we" must earn our right standing, and generally people like to control their own destinies.)*
3. **What is one thing in this world you think you need/ are really chasing after? Why is that so important to you?** *(Answers may vary. Leaders, make sure there is no condemnation. You may need to lead the way in being vulnerable and transparent. When it comes to the "why", lean into how the thing we chase will never satisfy.)*
4. **Most of Jesus's disciples are really struggling with the truth of Jesus's words. What teaching or command from Jesus is hardest for you to understand?** *(Answers may vary. Leaders, lean into the "why" behind the answers. Ask, "what's the real challenge you have with...."? Point back to who Jesus is, the Word of God, everything God wants the world to know in a person.)*

# DEEPEN

## [PLAY VIDEO]

Now, let's dive deeper into God's Word and see how we might apply it to our lives.

Have someone read John 6:66-71.

5. Has God ever "gone too far" in your life and really disrupted it? What did you experience and how did you feel or respond to God? *(Answers may vary.)*

6. Has anything ever made you consider walking away from following Jesus? What was it, and what happened? *(Answers may vary. Leaders, be ready to press in on anything that sounds like a present situation. Remember, none of us is meant to do this life alone, nor care for anyone alone. ## ACTION STEP

This week, spend time alone with God in a quiet place. Bring a journal or notepad, and write out all of your doubts, fears, questions and unanswered prayers. Before you leave that quiet time, share your fear, doubts, questions and unanswered prayers with one person in your group (text or email). Leaders, consider assigning partners or asking everyone to partner up during group for accountability.
